

Home Learning:

Monday – Spellings / Maths go out in home learning book. The children should write one sentence with each of their spelling words. Maths homework will be linked to our current Maths topic.

Friday – Return all homework. Spellings will be tested on a Friday morning.

Daily: Reading and Times Table Rock Stars

By the end of Year 3: Children should know by heart their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

By the end of Year 4: Children should know by heart all multiplication facts up to 12 x 12. Year 4 children will undertake a National Multiplication Tables Check.

PE:

PE will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. It is very important that pupils remember their kit- a white polo shirt and black or navy shorts. Long hair must be tied back and earrings removed or covered.
