Dear parents and carers,

We have come to the end of another half term and I would like to thank you for your continued support over the last few months, which have continued to be challenging for all of us. In the face of ongoing covid absences, we have managed to maintain levels of attendance which stand up well against national figures, and we should be proud of this achievement.
