## Home Learning:

By the end of Year 3: Children should know by heart their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
By the end of Year 4: Children should know by heart all multiplication facts up to $12 \times 12$. Year 4 children will undertake a National Multiplication Tables Check.
