- ✓ Group reading three times a week of a book that is aligned to the child's phonic knowledge.

- ✓ Write sentences with known letter-sound correspondences, some common exception words and using a full stop.
- \checkmark Read back their own work to check that it makes sense.
- Make simple predictions about a book they have read or heard, answer simple questions and ask their own questions to enhance understanding.

<u>Maths</u>
